

Enjoy more of Wyck with less traffic

Wyck will temporarily become low-traffic. This means fewer cars, vans and lorries will be allowed to drive through or park in the area. We're testing whether reducing traffic makes Wyck a more pleasant and safer place to be – with more space for pedestrians, cyclists and social connection.

How and when

From 5 January, you may only drive through and park on Wycker Brugstraat from Monday to Saturday between 7.00 and 18.00. So no access in the evenings, at night or on Sundays. There will also be set times and locations for loading and unloading.

Where can I park my car instead?

We realise this might take some getting used to. The good news is you'll still be able to park within walking distance of local shops and restaurants. You can use nearby Q-Park car parks such as Plein 1992, De Colonel and De Griend.

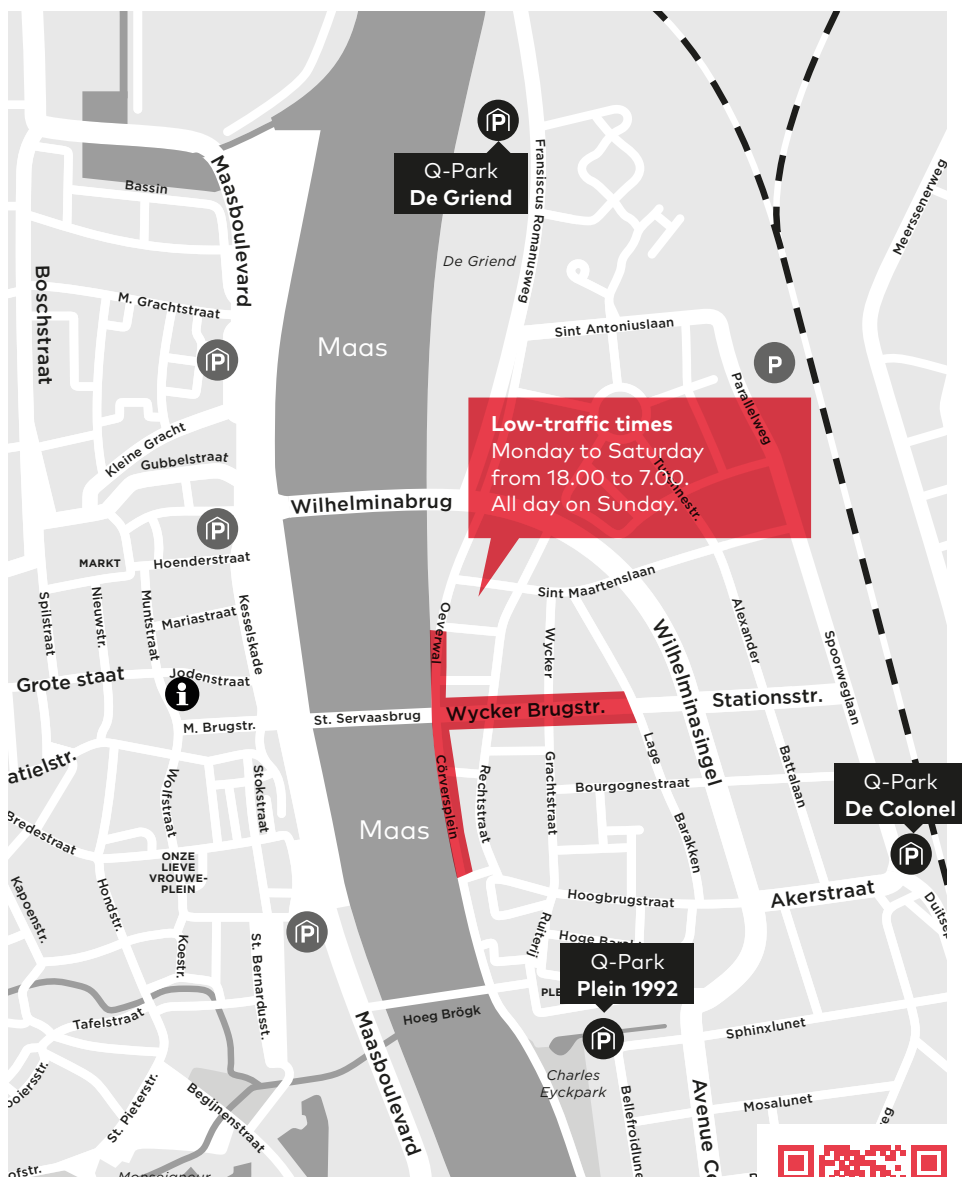
